**COURSE RESTRICTIONS FOR EXCHANGE STUDENT:**

All except for areas of Health Science programs and Graduate level students.

Courses in Dance, Languages, Theatre Arts and Cinema & Cultural Studies will be limited.

Business/Accounting major students are only allowed to register for a maximum of 3 BUS/ACC courses per semester, the courses will be selected every semester and a list will be sent out to the students prior to registration. To meet the minimum course load, business major students will be required to also select courses from other academic departments on campus.

Minimum course load 12 US credits. Maximum course load 17 US credits.

**LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY**

Only IBT TOEFL or IELTS scores will be considered for admission to Stony Brook University's Exchange/study abroad program. Stony Brook University does not accept TOEFL MyBest Scores.

TOEFL IBT: 80 or IELTS: 6.5
